Please bring your exhibits, large or small to the BA Vintage Country Fair on Saturday 16th & Sunday 17th May, 2020. This is our 17th year and the event over the past 16 years has supported local organisations, charities and Rotary Clubs.

Please find overleaf an Exhibitor Entry Form for completion. If anyone you know is interested in exhibiting, please photocopy the form overleaf and pass on. A copy of the entry form can be downloaded from our website: www.baevents.uk. The Committee is particularly interested in anyone who would like to exhibit/demonstrate bygone farming practices. We also welcome exhibitors to show their exhibits in the event's show ring. If you are interested in showing your exhibit and sharing the history of your machinery / vehicle with the public, please contact the ring co-ordinator on your arrival at the event.

It is our best intention to make this weekend as informative and fun as possible with demonstrations of ploughing and tractor pulling. There will be a 'Tractor Run' for any tractor wishing to take part on Sunday 17th commencing at 11am. There is a military encampment, 4 x 4 off road driving, working models on display, craft and commercial stands, pipe bands, refreshments and much more.

An area will be reserved for caravans and camping. Access will be allowed from Thursday 14th May at 4 pm. Passes (marked with a **C**) will be issued with wristbands and passes must be displayed. A strict no pass no entry policy will be in effect this year. It is essential that you please co-operate with the stewards who are there to ensure your safety and the smooth running of the event. Please note that the event is run by volunteers and no abuse, verbal or otherwise will be tolerated and could result in removal from the site. We reserve the right to refuse entry. Entertainment will be provided on Saturday evening in the marquee, please bring your own refreshments.

The entry form shown overleaf should be completed and returned to the address given no later than **13th April, 2020** if you wish your entry included in the event programme. Entries received after this date **will not** be included in the event programme.

All Exhibitors will be issued with two complimentary wristbands for their first exhibit, with one wristband issued per additional exhibit. **WRISTBANDS MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES.** Those exhibitors not wearing a wristband may be asked to pay an entrance fee. On arrival please park and register at Secretary's office at which time you will receive your exhibitor number and complimentary copy of the event programme. A commemorative plate will be available from the Secretary's office from 3pm on Sunday 17th.

As an entrance fee is not charged, it is essential to please send a Stamped Addressed Envelope with your entry form to cover postage as failing to do so costs the event a substantial amount each year. The envelope must be of an adequate size to fit caravan passes etc. Final details, safety regulations and passes will be mailed to you no later than 2 weeks prior to the event. **Passes will not be sent without SAE.**
